

INVITATION TO BID

ASPHALT PATCHING SERVICES

Separate sealed bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for performing pavement patching services for the Columbus Water Works will be received by the Owner at the offices of Columbus Water Works, 1421 Veterans Parkway, Columbus, Georgia 31902, until 10:00 AM, local time, on March 1, 2012 and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Sealed Bids must be clearly labeled, on the outside, "Pavement Patching Bid".

The project consists of removing temporary patches, installing concrete base and asphalt overlay in D.O.T. and City streets after a utility repair has been made by the Columbus Water Works and in accordance with all applicable City of Columbus Ordinances and/or DOT regulations. The engineer's estimate for this work is \$550,000.00

Employment of Local Businesses and Contractors: It is the wish of the Owner that local businesses, including contractors, be given the opportunity to bid on the various parts of the work.

The desire on the part of the Owner to encourage participation of minority and locally owned businesses and contractors is not intended to restrict or limit competitive bidding. The Owner supports a healthy, free market system that seeks to include responsible local businesses and provide ample opportunities for local business growth and development.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive informalities and to re-advertise.
