Recycle Your Grease This Summer...



To reduce the impact of Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) on our sewer system, CWW developed a FOG Program requiring restaurants to control the amount of grease they release into the system. These controls include good kitchen practices, containment of the FOG, and removal.

This program was then expanded to include both households as well as 11 grease collection sites where people can drop off their used grease at any time.

Since 2014, CWW has collected a total of 597,467 gallons of fats, oil, and grease. That's a lot of FOG!

Have you been saving your used cooking grease? If so, drop off your used cooking grease to any one of our 11 collection sites throughout the city. Sites are available 24/7/365.

24/7 Payment Kiosk

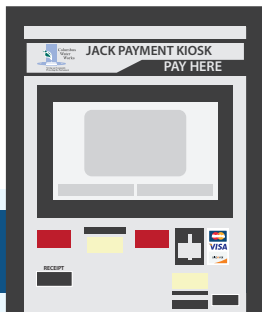
